We received a certified letter from Wyss Associates that was postmarked August 27, 2012. The letter contained a "NOTICE OF HEARING FOR A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT" for what appears to be Destination Rapid City to use the Memorial Park Promenade in the Flood Hazard District.
