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SUMMARY OF ADOPTION ACTION

Amendment to the Comprehensive Plan

On July 1, 2013, the Rapid City Council approved an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan. The amendment will revise the Comprehensive Plan to change the land use designation from Public to Residential for a portion of the NW1/4 of the SE1/4 of Section 9, T1N, R8E, BHM Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota, more fully described as follows: Commencing at the northeasterly corner of Tract A of the E1/2 of the SW1/4 and W1/2 of the SE1/4, thence, S 00°21'28" W, a distance of 214.98' to a point on the easterly boundary of said Tract A, and the point of beginning. Thence, first course: S 89°53'48" E a distance of 113.90', Thence, second course: S 89°53'48" E a distance of 620.00'; Thence, third course: S 00°00'00" E a distance of 784.32'; Thence, fourth course: N 90°00'00" W a distance of 620'; Thence, fifth course: N 00°00'00" E, a distance of 785.44'; Thence, sixth course N 89°53'48" W, a distance of 113.90', to the said point of beginning., more generally described south of SD Highway 44 and east of Elk Vale Road, and containing approximately 11.17 acres, more or less.
