END OF CONSENT ITEMS

Motion was made by Nordstrom, second by Roberts to (No. PW061113-07) Authorize Mayor and Finance Officer to Sign Amendment No. 1 to Agreement Number 613517 between the City of Rapid City and the South Dakota Department of Transportation for the 6th Street Pedestrian Crossing on Omaha Street (For Promenade Project). Scott addressed the status of the Promenade Project noting the recent Main Street Square publicity articles. Scott commented on the continued growth of the Summer Nights event and the possible future venue changes. Lewis clarified that the Omaha Crossing project is being fully funded by Destination Rapid City. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Scott, second by Laurenti to (No. PW061113-12) Acknowledge the Feasibility Study and Recommendation on the Installation of Sidewalks on Both Sides of Highway 44 from La Crosse Street to Western Dakota Technical Institute and Authorize Staff to Pursue Grant Funding Options. Sasso complemented staff for their research into grant funding for the project. Noting that the sidewalk would serve Western Dakota VoTech and the East Library, Sasso encouraged revisiting the issue in July 2014 should the grant request be unsuccessful. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Nordstrom, second by Roberts to (No. PW061113-16) Approve a Request from Craig Snyder for an Exception to Waive the Requirement to Install Sidewalk per City Ordinance 12.08.060 for the Property Located along Emerson Lane– Lot 3 of Block 2 of Northstar Subdivision, Section 29, T2N, R8E, BHM, Pennington County, South Dakota with the stipulation that a waiver of right to protest (WORP) is signed. Sasso voiced support for the sidewalk installation based on the Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan recommendation and the future reconstruction of Segar Drive. Nordstrom indicated that the Waiver is recommended due to the isolated location. Motion carried with Sasso voting No.

Motion was made by Scott, second by Roberts that Ordinance No. 5932, in conjunction with the associated Comprehensive Plan Amendment, be placed upon its first reading and the title was fully and distinctly read and second reading set for Monday, July 1, 2013.
