Adult Day Service

- Location – 4110 Winfield Street, Rapid City, SD 57701
- Lot 2R in block Nineteen (19) of Robinsdale Subdivision #10, Sections Eighteen (18), Township One North (T1N), Range Eight East of the Black Hills Meridian (R8E BHM)
- 35 – 40 participants with disabilities on any given day
- Adult Disabilities – Alzheimer's, Dementia, Parkinson's, Frail elderly, Cerebral Palsy, Traumatic Brain Injury, just to name a few.
- Teen Disabilities – Autism, Developmental Disabilities, Brain Injury, Cerebral Palsy, and again just to name a few.
- Most all participants are transported by three of our WRDI buses. None of our participants drive.
- Open five days a week
- Hours are from 7:00 in the morning to 6:00 in the evening
- Hours could vary for emergencies
- Staff at this time:
 - 6 – Full Time Staff
 - 4 – Part Time Staff
 - 1 – Manager
- Funding Sources:
 - Veterans Administration
 - 3-B State dollars
 - Long term Care dollars
 - Private Pay
- Provide home cooked meals for all whether they can afford it or not
- Snacks throughout the day
- Personal care such as showering participants, shaving, finger and toe nail care
- Beauty Shop that gives perms, cuts, and care of scalp
- Activities consist of exercise, games, arts & craft, cards, and group activities
- Cognitive activities of memorization, important dates to remember, memory cards
- Outings
- Ice cream socials
- Gardening

Parking Space Requirements:

Maximum Number of Clients	30 spaces
30 Clients X .1 space/client	3 spaces
Staff Maximum 6	6 spaces
Staff Shift Change Provisions	3 spaces
Transportation Van Storage	3 spaces
Total Required Parking	<u>15 spaces</u>

*Please note that one van Accessible parking is included in the above requirements.

* *Please note that we are requesting an exception:*
A minimum of 20 clients are transported daily. The transportation requirement will reduce the client based parking space requirement by the following:

1. 20 Clients transported X .1 space/client equals less 2 spaces
2. The space requirement reduction will reduce the total of spaces required by 2 which equals 12 spaces
3. The PW engineer expressed a concern with the 80' Distance for turn around on the three north parking spaces.

***The three parking spaces will primarily be used for transportation van storage. The three transportation vans that the center now has are used to provide transportation to and from the center as well as other activities. The vans are most likely to be out in the morning and afternoon. We do not for see a problem for our van drivers to use the three spaces along with the additional van accessible parking space for loading and offloading.
