I've been working with my neighbors to provide the planning commission with petitions against the request by the Cornerstone Rescue Mission to request a special use permit for a homeless women and children shelter at 301 Fox Run DR.

My neighbor Bill DeWall has stopped down to your office and submitted the first round of petitions that we have gathered. I am attaching to this email a second round of petitions collected.

In addition to the attached petitions, I have also attached a report of 911 calls to the current location of the Cornerstone Homeless Women and Children shelter at 404 Columbus ST. This report from the Rapid City police Department covers the period of September 1st, 2006 through October 22nd, 2014. There were 213 incidents that have been called into 911 from the current shelter.

I requested the same report for the same time range for the 301 Fox Run Drive, the proposed new location for the shelter. There were 3 911 calls for same period of time. We request that this information is strongly considered and presented by the planning commission. Approving this special use in our quiet low density, low crime neighborhood will introduce a large increase of crime which is in complete conflict with the quiet, safety, and security that has been a cornerstone of this neighborhood since its existence, due in large part to the careful and thoughtful zoning of the Rapid City Planning commission itself.

#### Dear Ms Fisher,

I am writing to express my opposition to the relocation of the Cornerstone Women & Children's shelter to the proposed site on Fox Run Drive at Fifth Street.

We have lived in the Fox Run neighborhood for 23 years. We have had the opportunity to observe the rapid and massive growth of Rapid City, in an orderly manner, to the south of Rapid City Regional Hospital. We feel the growth has been healthy and well managed for the most part and most issues of traffic, land use and development have been addressed as need arose.

We are also adamant supporters of the Cornerstone Mission and the work they do so it was with some curiosity and interest that we received the news of the proposed move of the annex from Quincy Street to the corner of Fox Run Drive and Fifth Street.

The Quincy Street location is a quiet street and is reasonably near to the main mission facility. there is no fast traffic and yards are fenced to make safe play space for children away from the street. We are aware that the location has been too small for the need for some time. We commend the Mission for seeking to expand to meet the need, but the move to a relatively small lot along one of the busiest streets in Rapid City seems not to be in the best interest of the Mission or it's clients.

At the time the current structure at Fox Run and Fifth was constructed, one of the questions for approval of the permit was whether there was adequate room for parking for a "medium density" facility. Since the purpose of the facility was to serve very elderly home-bound people in an assisted living (these people did not have cars to park and visitation traffic was minimal) the facility was approved. Staff was limited to a couple of cars as the owners were the primary care-givers and lived on site. One of the reasons the assisted living was vacated was to allow the owners to buy a larger property so there would be room for expansion--which they did.

When the hospital bought the property it was used primarily by their staff for their medical equipment center so there was very little traffic.

In subsequent years we saw the extension of Fifth Street to the bypass and Minnesota Street to Highway 79. Additionally, the Westhills Village complex was built and added to several times and hundreds of new homes have been built in the immediate area. All of this has caused an exponential increase in traffic on Fifth Street as well as Fox Run Drive. During the morning and evening "rush" hours it is virtually impossible to turn left from Fox Run Drive on to Fifth. It is somewhat dangerous even to make a right turn onto Fifth as the Texas Street traffic light is just a few hundred feet to the south and traffic often backs up past Fox Run Drive.

Now the city is considering allowing the mission to relocate families to one of the busiest streets in town where the traffic is very fast and congestion is a major issue daily, parking is grossly inadequate for a residential facility of this size, and there is no room for future growth. Does this really sound like the best choice for the mission?

As homeowners in the neighborhood we already deal with traffic issues to exit the Fox Run development, fast traffic using Fox Run Drive as a throughway to Highway 16 and semi-trucks making deliveries, several times a week, to Westhills Village and Echo Ridge, which sits at the top of Fox Run Drive. More population density in this neighborhood is hardly what is advisable.

It seems to us that the plan to utilize this property for the mission home is negative for the clients living in the home and for us as neighbors.

The mission should be considering property where future expansion is a possibility, there is adequate parking currently, and there will be room for generous play space for children away from traffic and noise. We understand that the building on the property will lend itself well to the use of the families--it may be that that could be relocated to a more appropriate property where the other criteria are met.

We have been shown a copy of the police reports at the current Women and Children's Shelter and are quite concerned about the number of calls for police intervention over recent years.

For all of the above reasons, we request that the Planning Commission and the Rapid City Council not allow the Cornerstone Women and Children's Shelter to the property on the corner of Fox Run Drive and Fifth Street. We request that you make this information known to the planning commission and the city council

This is written in concern of the "Proposed" group home at 301 Fox Run Dr. approved at the Rapid City Planning Commission and appealed to the City Council.

When the developers of Fox Run subdivision laid out plans for its development, the property at 301 Fox Run Dr. was zoned to allow only "Medium Density Residential" development on both the North and South sides of Fox Run Dr. adjacent to Fifth Street. That being the rules as laid out by the planning department, the parcel to the north side of Fox Run Dr. was purchased by a Church for their use. The parcel lying south of Fox Run Dr. was purchased and built as a 15 bed Assisted Living Facility initially, then allowed to add an additional 15 bed building on the property as most residents didn't drive, the parking was sufficient. Over the next few years, Fox Run residential neiborhood built out to be a quiet enjoyable place to reside away from the noise and traffic of downtown.

Then developers purchased the church property turning it into two large medical office buildings, a bank, and an additional office building. Next, the assisted living facility was purchased by Regional Hospital, rezoned from MDR to Office Commercial and used as a medical supply co., thus the history of the property and adjacent area of 301 Fox Run Dr.

Several issues affect the proposed change in use of this property now:

There is inadequate parking, only enough to accommodate residents and staff not allowing any space for delivery's, service vehicles, family members of residents or their friends that would visit, maintenance vehicles, vans or busses to move children or residences to and from school, appointments, jobs, shopping, medical appointments.

There are two additional bedrooms designated as no use areas in this building plus a complete additional building capable in the future to accommodate twice the residents now proposed for a total of over 80 possible residents on this 1 acre parcel with no additional parking or play area. This is equivalent of a medium sized motel on this site. As we have seen with the history of the property to the north of Fox Run Dr. it can easily happen. If this proposed action is approved by this Council, it should only be under the condition of removal of the "NO USE" building presently on this site.

The last paragraph in their "Letter of Intent" states that: "Access to the facility would be almost exclusively from 5<sup>th</sup> street, with no likely increase traffic on any residential streets." This is not true as it takes access directly from Fox Run Dr. only a short distance from 5<sup>th</sup> street which causes multiple problems for access to 5<sup>th</sup> street. Planning staff stated at Planning Commission meeting that no traffic study was necessary for this request. With the increase in traffic on 5<sup>th</sup> street as a result of the new South Wal-Mart along with residential and Medical Facility development in the area, as well as traffic

cutting thru Fox Run Dr. from HI way 16 to 5<sup>th</sup> street, and the addition last year to the parking lot and approach onto Fox Run Dr. from the VA medical facility it has caused tremendous change since the subdivision was designed as a small residential street. Also, the approach of Fox Run Dr. does not align with the approach on the east side of 5<sup>th</sup> street to the apartments. When a vehicle is waiting in the left turn lane to go east to the apartments, it blocks the Fox Run Dr. traffic from getting onto 5<sup>th</sup> street going north.

In the past few weeks, temporary barricades were placed on HI way 16 to start the 8<sup>th</sup> street project. Many cars chose to come thru Fox Run Dr. rather than narrow to one lane and continue down 8<sup>th</sup> street thus contributing additional traffic. Although temporary, there is much 8<sup>th</sup> street construction to come in the next few years.

There is "No Parking" signs posted on both sides of Fox Run Dr. adjacent to 5<sup>th</sup> street but are ignored and are not enforced.

Over 200 calls for police or emergency services have been placed for the existing group facility. One as recently as last week as reported in the Journal police blotter as drug related. The existing group home is approximately 2 blocks from the police station, the Fox Run Dr. property is over 2 miles.

Neither myself nor any resident of Fox Run Dr. are against group homes or the homeless of our city as Mr. Castleberry stated in the Rapid City Journal. In fact we believe they need more than is offered at this proposed facility such as a children's indoor play area for up to 27 children that is larger than a small residential home living room as well as outside area to not be adjacent to a 4 lane busy main arterial street.

Please consider the wellbeing of these Children and conditions offered not only to them but future planning proposals that affect the residents of Fox Run Dr. and our entire community.
