FEDERAL AID BRIDGE REPLACEMENT OR REHABILITATION PROGRAM RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the <u>City of Rapid City</u> desires the <u>replacement</u> of the bridge hereinafter described:

LOCATION AND LENGTH: The crossing of Rapid Creek stream on Creek Drive 0.4N of St. Patrick Street 84.5'long (structure no.52-432-308)

AND WHEREAS, the <u>City of Rapid City</u> is obligated and hereby agrees to provide proper maintenance as required by the Federal Highway Act as amended and supplemented thereto for project after construction is completed and to regulate or cause to be regulated the installation of the utility facilities within the limits of the right-of-way of the proposed project in accordance with State and Federal requirements.

AND WHEREAS, the <u>City of Rapid City</u> is obligated and hereby agrees to reimburse the State for all costs not reimbursable with the Special Bridge Replacement Funds.

AND WHEREAS, the bridge is in need of replacement for the following reasons:

- 1. The sufficiency rating is <u>37.3</u>.
- 2. The bridge is not located on a Minimum Maintenance Road.
- 3. The bridge is located on a <u>school bus</u> route, a <u>mail</u> route, a <u>commercial</u> <u>access</u> route, and a <u>residential collector</u> route.
- 4. The load carrying capacity of the existing bridge <u>cannot</u> be improved to carry legal loads by rehabilitation of the existing bridge.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the South Dakota Department of Transportation be and is hereby authorized and requested to program for construction, in accordance with the approved Secondary Road Plan Agreement and the State's "Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges", the bridge replacement or rehabilitation project at the above described location. Consultant services are to be with Federal Participation. Preliminary Engineering Services by State Forces with Federal Participation are the Hydraulic Study and the Foundations Investigation (if necessary). Construction administration is to be handled by City and/or State forces with Federal Participation.

The <u>City of Rapid City</u> will have \$125,000 available during calendar year <u>2005</u> to match available Special Bridge Replacement Funds.
