With this letter I am requesting the City of Rapid City grant me a building permit to build a reinforced concrete retaining wall in City right of way at 4295 Rosemary Lane. The proposed wall would be approximately 90 feet long and four feet high. I wish to build in the right of way because to build on my property would require the removal of several full size trees and leave a four foot wide grass strip between the sidewalk and the wall which would require additional planting and maintanence. To build on my property would also require excavation of approximately 2000 cubic feet of material [90'X7'X4'] making this a much larger project than necessary. 








View along Wonderland Drive , facing West , showing proposed retaining wall area.




View along Wonderland Drive, facing West, showing proposed retaining wall area.


