RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Resolution to change the road name from Hoefer Court to Julia Court for the cul-de-sac street located in the southeast corner of Section 7, T1N, R8E, BHM, Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota be approved and that a street sign be posted.

GENERAL COMMENTS:

The applicant has submitted a road name change request for an approximate 150 foot long cul-de-sac street that extends south from Hoefer Avenue. In particular, the applicant is requesting to change the name of the street from Hoefer Court to Julia Court.

The applicant currently owns all of the adjacent lots that abut Hoefer Court. In addition, the lots are void of any structural development. As such, there are no existing addresses that need to be changed as a part of the proposed road name change.

STAFF REVIEW:

The Emergency Services Communication Center has reviewed the proposed new street name of Julia Court and is recommending approval. In addition, staff has noted that another cul-de-sac street located north of the subject property is also named Hoefer Court. As such, renaming the street as proposed will preclude any future confusion once addresses are assigned for this cul-de-sac street. Staff will notify all affected agencies of the street renaming after the City Council approves the request.

Staff is recommending that the resolution to change the road name from Hoefer Court to Julia Court be approved and that a street sign be posted on the site.
