Karl Kinzie, Supervisor, Equipment Maintenance Shop, and I field inspected the four trucks that were in the lower cost of bids today, and at the conclusion of our inspection, and as per the attached e-mail from Karl, I recommend award to J.D. Evans for the 1994 Autocar tanker truck for a price of \$28,500. This truck is listed in their inventory at \$62,500 and is currently on a 6 month lease to the South Dakota Army National Guard. We would receive delivery in @6months. Upon inspection of this truck we found it in exceptional condition for the price and it would be a significant improvement over our current water trucks. The National Guard, as per their lease, must return the truck in like condition at the time of their rental. This is a significant savings to the City and will ultimately get us a good truck. After inspection of the used tanker trucks two offered by J. D. Evans and two offered by Diesel Machinery

Inc., on the bidding process, I would strongly support the bid of \$28,500.00 for the 1994 Autocar truck tanker that is being offered by J D Evans, Inc. If Jerry can wait the 180 day delivery period that has been stipulated in the bid. The price was to also install a water cannon which they were to mount on the machine,

which is very acceptable to me if it is installed on the rear of water tank, possibly on the extended frame of the truck and not the front of the truck. Hose reel and hose needs to be left on the rear of the truck also. I believe that we needed to also come to an agreement with J D Evans that the truck will still be

in the same useable condition when it is delivered to us at the end of the five month lease period that it is out on.
