Dirk,

As part of the nitrate remediation plan for the Water Reclamation Facility's old biosolids disposal site, we are required to conduct deep soil sampling and analysis. Composite samples need to be taken down to a 12 to 16 foot depth. This requires specialized sampling equipment and procedures.

Attached are two quotes from local testing firms for this sampling and analysis. The attached quotations are from FMG for \$4,925.50, and from American Engineering and Testing for \$4,762.95 if a hollow stem auger can be used, or for \$4,372.65 if a direct push rig can be used. (If significant cobbles are present, they will have to use the hollow stem auger rig.)

I recommend acceptance of the AET proposal. The attached contract is a revised version as per the recommendation from the attorneys office, but has not received their final review and stamp.
