## RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Fence Height Exception to allow a ten foot high fence in lieu of a four foot high fence around the Basketball and Volleyball Courts be continued to the January 31, 2006 Public Works meeting.

GENERAL COMMENTS: The applicant is seeking an exception to allow a ten foot high fence in a Medium Density Residential Zoning District. The proposed fence will be located within an apartment complex and will serve as perimeter fencing around the basketball and tennis courts for the complex. The proposed fence will be ten feet in height and will be constructed of chain link.

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STAFF REVIEW: In residential zoning districts a screening fence with a maximum height of six feet are allowed in side and rear yards. Exceptions to the height requirements may be approved by the City Council. The applicant is requesting an exception to allow a ten foot high chain link fence to be located around the basketball and tennis courts of Homestead Gardens Apartments.

Section 15.40 .040 of the Rapid City Municipal Code states that a variance to the fence height requirements can be granted by the City Council if the exception is not contrary to the public interest and the exception will not be injurious to the surrounding neighborhood.

Location: The proposed location of the fence is within 8 feet of the lot line between Lots 5 and 6 of the Big Sky Subdivision, an adjacent single family residential development. Staff is concerned that the location of the basketball court in relation to the single family residences may create noise that will be injurious to the surrounding neighborhood. Staff is recommending that prior to Public Works Committee approval, a revised site plan be submitted showing that the proposed basketball court relocated away from the single family residence or that it has been removed from the site.

Design: As previously indicated the proposed fence will be constructed of chain link. Construction of the fence must comply with the description and elevations submitted with the application.

Staff recommends that the request for a Fence Height Exception be continued to allow the applicant time to submit a revised plan.
