Submit advertisement for bids to Rapid City Journal and Construction Industry Center Print and issue drawings and specifications to bidders, and four (4) copies to the City of Rapid City.

Prepare and submit bid documents on the City of Rapid City Microsoft Excel form. Conduct/Direct a Pre-bid Conference.

Issue addenda to the bid documents as required.

Review and provide recommendations pertaining to pre-qualification of contractors, when applicable.

Attend the bid opening (to be held at the City Finance Office).

Attend Public Works Committee and Council Meetings as required.

Prepare the Bid Tab in City of Rapid City Microsoft Excel project book format and submit this and a printed hard copy to the Public Works Department within one (1) working day of the bid opening. Forward a copy of the final bid tab to all bidders.

Prepare a recommendation regarding awarding the contract.

Prepare contracts and submit to contractor for execution.

Review construction contract documents and other submittals from the contractor and submit to Public Works Department for City Attorney's approval and signatures of the Mayor and Finance Officer.

Prepare a Notice to Proceed for execution and signature by City Project Manager and distribute the same to the successful contractor and others as applicable.

m. Full time Construction Observation and Administration services as follows:

Construction Observation services will include full time on-site observation, to assure that the methods and materials used by the contractor meet the intent of the drawings and specifications in completion of the work. A daily record of activity will be maintained by the inspector including weather conditions, construction progress, deviations from the drawings and specifications, work performed, quantities installed and any other pertinent information. Such information shall be neatly and concisely entered into the City of Rapid City Project Inspector's Diary and Inspection book to insure that the drawings and specifications are complied with. Photos of work will be provided showing key elements of construction as well as documentation for questionable workmanship. Completed bound copies of the field notes, photos and daily record will be provided to the City of Rapid City at the end of the project. The City of Rapid City Engineering Division's "Construction Project Close-Out Checklist" shall be modified as appropriate for the project and shall be completed by the consultant. All test results and an "as-built" set of drawings shall be submitted to the City of Rapid City within 30 days of project completion.

Construction Administration services for the project includes conducting a preconstruction conference, approving project "shop drawings" and submittals, conducting weekly project coordination and progress meetings, providing monthly pay estimates on City of Rapid City forms, preparing a final construction punch list, submitting a certificate of completion and start of warranty period letter to the City of Rapid City signed by a professional engineer, distribute Public Service Announcements (P.S.A.'s) to all local media and the Public Works Department, prepare "As Built" drawings and specifications on 22"X34" Mylar and on CD compatible with AutoCAD Release 2006 format, and attend and participate in a post construction project review and critique

- o. Restart Kickoff Meeting and Project Management
- p. Additional Weekly Progress meetings
- 3. Construction Observation will be invoiced as a separate task with hourly rates as attached with a maximum not to exceed \$49.186.
- 4. Construction Services for the Structural Subconsultant shall be compensated at the hourly rates and reimbursable expenses attached with a maximum limiting fee of \$21,000. This task requires City Project Managers authorization to proceed.

A2. For the Additional Services or the modifications to services set forth above, OWNER shall pay ENGINEER the following modified compensation:

Original Contract: \$275,100 (Two Hundred Seventy Five Thousand, One Hundred Dollars)

Revised Contract: \$367,323 (Three Hundred Sixty Seven Thousand, Three Hundred Twenty

Three Dollars)

Increase of: \$92,223 (Ninety Two Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty Three Dollars)
