As a property owner and concerned resident of West Chicago Street, I am sending an email in lieu of attending the meeting scheduled for February 6 as I have a commitment at work that will not allow me to be present.

I am **not** in favor of 30 foot light poles in a residential neighborhood (no matter how much traffic may use the street). I am **not** in favor of lighting this area like a commercial district.

I am in favor of nicely lit residential areas, and understand the importance of lighting with respect to safety issues. However, over lighting an area is just as big a concern. The amount of light and the style of light poles have a large impact on the feel of the neighborhood and the value of my property and those properties surrounding it.

I believe the light posts should be kept in the boulevard area at the height the existing light poles are at, so they don't interfere with the overhead utilities . . . in addition, the money saved by not having to supply utilities to the south side of the street could be put toward getting light poles that are attractive and enhance the neighborhood rather than de-valuing the area.

I hope we are able to come to an agreement and improve the lighting on West Chicago without making our neighborhood look like a commercial district.
