# SECTION 01230 BID ALTERNATES

#### PART 1 - GENERAL

# 1.1 RELATED DOCUMENTS

A. Drawings and general provisions of the Contract, including General and Supplementary Conditions and other Division 1 Specification Sections, apply to this Section.

# 1.2 SUMMARY

A. This Section includes administrative and procedural requirements for bid alternates.

# 1.3 DEFINITIONS

- A. Bid Alternate: An amount proposed by Bidders and stated on the Bid Proposal Form for certain work defined in the Bidding Requirements that may be added to or deducted from the Base Bid amount if Owner decides to accept a corresponding change either in the amount of construction to be completed or in the products, materials, equipment, systems, or installation methods described in the Contract Documents.
  - The cost or credit for each alternate is the net addition to or deduction from the Contract Sum to incorporate alternate into the Work. No other adjustments are made to the Contract Sum.

# 1.4 PROCEDURES

- Coordination: Modify or adjust affected adjacent work as necessary to completely integrate work of the alternate into Project.
  - Include as part of each alternate, miscellaneous devices, accessory objects, and similar items incidental to or required for a complete installation whether or not indicated as part of alternate.
- B. Notification: Immediately following award of the Contract, notify each party involved, in writing, of the status of each alternate. Indicate if alternates have been accepted, rejected, or deferred for later consideration. Include a complete description of negotiated modifications to alternates.
- C. Execute accepted alternates under the same conditions as other work of the Contract.
- D. Schedule: A Schedule of Bid Alternates is included at the end of this Section. Specification Sections referenced in schedule contain requirements for materials necessary to achieve the work described under each alternate.

# 3.1 BASE BID

A. Base Bid for this project includes construction of the Dahl Arts Center Addition and Remodel project as described in Section 01100 – Summary, paragraph 1.3, including Partial Completion/Temporary Occupancy requirements as described in Section 01100, paragraph 1.6, and with a Substantial Completion date of August 4, 2008. #### 3.2 SCHEDULE OF ALTERNATES

- A. <u>Bid Alternate #1</u>: Lump Sum Price to be deducted from the Base Bid to delete the majority of the work to upgrade the Dahl Arts Center basement (Base Bid to include work shown on Drawing Sheet A1.10 and related mechanical and electrical). See Drawing Sheet A1.12 for alternate demo plan, floor plan and finish schedule for this area (see Mechanical and Electrical for additional bid alternate information).
- B. <u>Bid Alternate #2</u>: Lump Sum Price to be added to the Base Bid to replace existing glazing and metal panels on the Annex Building (Base Bid to include painting the existing metal panels).
- C. <u>Bid Alternate #3</u>: Lump Sum Price to be added to the Base Bid to provide and install Main Lobby flooring per Architectural Drawing Sheet 5.02 (Base Bid to include wall base and sealed concrete floor).
- D. <u>Bid Alternate #4</u>: Lump Sum Price to be added to the Base Bid to provide landscape for the area southeast and southwest of the existing Dahl Arts Center Building per drawings (see Civil Plans for Base Bid information).
- E. <u>Bid Alternate #5</u>: Lump Sum Price to be deducted from the Base Bid to delete the installation of the Card Key Access System (rough-in to remain in project and is not part of this deduct alternate).
- F. <u>Bid Alternate #6</u>: Lump Sum Price to be deducted from the Base Bid to substitute aluminum feeders of equal ampacity in lieu of copper feeders at all panelboards and switchboard feeders 100 amps or above (excluding the service entrance feeders). This alternate will require the Contractor to increase feeder and conduit sizes as required and may increase feeder run quantities where parallel feeders are required. An equivalent ampacity to the copper feeders shown on plans is required. The Contractor shall be responsible for configuration compatibilities. The aluminum feeders shall be equal to Alcan Series 8000 Alloy, XHHW. Submittal for equal conductors will be accepted for consideration. The aluminum feeders shall be terminated with dual-rated mechanical connectors listed for aluminum feeders service (75C) as recommended by the cable manufacturer. All terminations shall be treated with a joint compound (anti-oxidizing agent as recommended by the cable manufacturer/supplier, equal to Penn-Union). The Contractor shall comply with and document all torque values. The installation shall comply with NECA/AA 104-2006.
- G. <u>Bid Alternate #7</u>: Lump Sum Price to remove the existing exterior windows at the Annex and replace windows as shown on the Architectural Drawing Sheets.
