RE: Request Authorization to Seek Proposals for Engineering Services for Project ST08-1701 CIP #50398 Universal Drive Reconstruction

Staff proposes to reconstruct approximately 1,500 feet of Universal Drive from the City limits to Deadwood Avenue. The existing asphalt street between the Windmill Truck Stop and Deadwood Avenue has been severely rutted due to the heavy truck traffic. It's anticipated that this segment of road will be reconstructed with concrete while the west segment will be asphalt.

Staff proposes to hire a Consult to be responsible for designing the project. Funding for this project will be from the Street Fund. The project budget is \$615,000, which includes design and construction costs.

Staff proposes to design and bid the project in 2008, and anticipates construction to be completed in the fall of 2008.

The project will result in a new street surface with an anticipated useful life of approximately 20-30 years.
