As per our discussion on Friday, April 12, 2008, we are requesting permission to advertise to purchase one new trash compactor for the landfill at an estimated price of \$500,000. The current machine used as our primary compactor has approximately 9800 hours on it and this machine has recently experienced mechanical problems. Currently, our back up machine is a 1998 model with approximately 17,000 hours on it. Purchase of a new machine is absolutely essential if we are to have a primary compactor, low in hours, with a high degree of dependability, available for daily operations. The 1998 machine will be traded off in this purchase.

We will defer purchasing the scheduled yard waste processing equipment in the 2008 budget, budgeted at \$330,000, to the 2009 budget. This is being done to assist in the cash flow for this purchase. It will also give us adequate time to acquire the state grant in October. The state grant, if received, would be later this year, and the yard waste processing equipment in the grant application, would more appropriately be purchased in 2009.
