RESOLUTION NO. 2009-062 RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING ACCEPTANCE OF TATANKA ROAD AND HARLEY DRIVE RIGHT OF WAY.

WHEREAS, the State of South Dakota ("State") through its Department of Transportation reconstructed Exit 55 on Interstate 90; and

WHEREAS, as part of this project, the City and State agreed a service road known as Lange Road needed to be relocated to the north side of the adjacent properties; and

WHEREAS, the City and State entered into an agreement on January 20, 2003, which specified the parties mutual obligations with respect to the relocation of the service road; and

WHEREAS, the State agreed to acquire the right of way necessary to construct the new service roads and the City agreed to accept responsibility for and maintain the roads; and

WHEREAS, the service road has been relocated and is now known as Tatanka Rd. and Harley Drive; and

WHEREAS, the State is requesting that the City approve a formal resolution accepting the completed service roads.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Rapid City formally accepts from the State the right of way for Tatanka Road and Harley Drive, including all maintenance responsibility for the roads, to fulfill its obligations under the agreement dated January 20, 2003.
