Staff proposes to hire a Consultant to be responsible for designing the project, bidding the project, and providing construction observation, administration and project closeout.

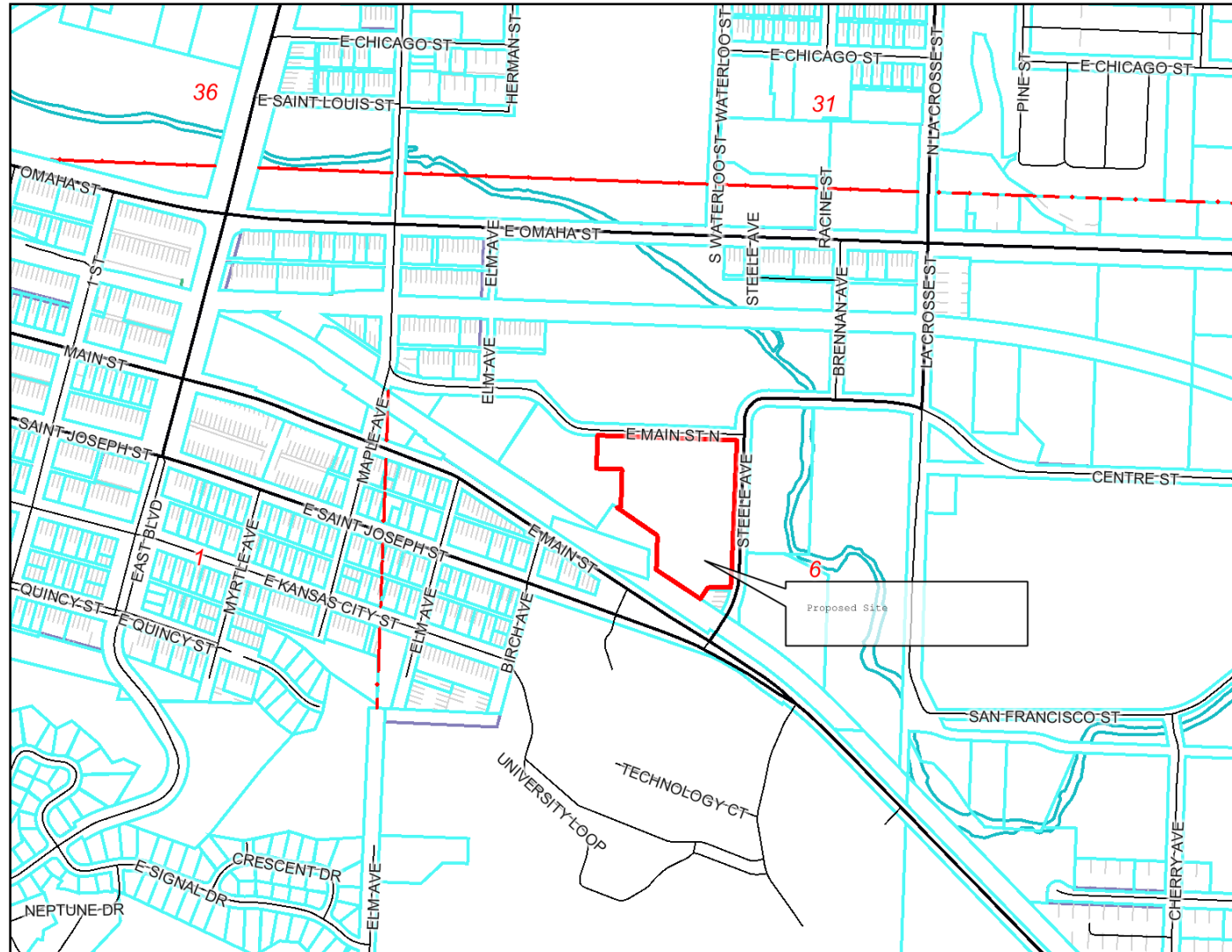
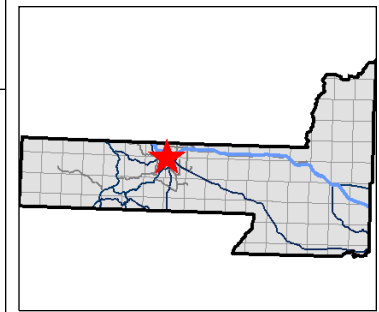
The project is funded from Public Works Enterprise Funds, Street Division General Funds and Federal Transit Administration Grants. The project budget is \$400,000 to \$500,000.
