AMENDMENT NUMBER 2 AGREEMENT NUMBER 713341

BACKGROUND:

- On January 31, 2007, the State of South Dakota, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, referred to as "STATE," and the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, referred to as "CITY," entered into an funding agreement for letting and construction of Project P 1648(2), PCN 0116, and CITY sanitary sewer and water projects SSW 04-1397 and SSW 06-1497, which agreement, referred to in this Amendment as "AGREEMENT," was signed by representatives of each party and assigned agreement number 713341 by the STATE; and,
- 2. Having previously amended the AGREEMENT, the parties now wish to further amend the AGREEMENT to change the funding source for payments.

THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Paragraph A. 4 of the AGREEMENT is revised to read as follows:
 - 4. Make all eligible progress payments for URBAN PROJECT to contractors and vendors with 81.95% HPP Discretionary Funds originally obtained through project EM 1648(01), PCN 00UR and 18.05% CITY match. Any costs in excess of the available HPP Discretionary Funds and CITY match, will be paid for as originally intended with 81.95% CITY STP funds and 18.05% STATE match.
- 2. Paragraph B. 9 is added to the AGREEMENT as follows:
 - 9. Reimburse STATE for the 18.05% CITY match associated with the HPP Discretionary Funds. The CITY will pay STATE within thirty (30) days of receipt of billings from the STATE.
- 3. Except as specifically modified by this Amendment, all terms and conditions of the original AGREEMENT along with the prior amendment, will remain in full force and effect.
- 4. CITY has designated its Mayor as CITY'S authorized representative and has empowered the Mayor with the authority to sign this Amendment on behalf of the CITY. A copy of CITY'S Commission minutes or resolution authorizing the execution of this Amendment by the Mayor as CITY'S authorized representative is attached to this Amendment as Exhibit A.

This Amendment is binding upon the signatories hereto not as individuals, but solely in their capacities as officials of their respective organizations and acknowledges proper action of STATE and CITY to enter into the same.
