**SPECIFICATIONS FOR
Hot Mixed Asphaltic Concrete
Rapid City, South Dakota**

Bids will be received at the Rapid City Finance Office, 300 Sixth Street, Rapid City, South Dakota on March 13, 2012, until 2:00 P.M. for furnishing HOT MIXED ASPHALTIC CONCRETE which shall meet the following specifications:

SCOPE

It is the intent of these specifications to describe HOT MIXED ASPHALTIC CONCRETE in sufficient detail to secure bids on comparable HOT MIXED ASPHALTIC CONCRETE. All parts not specifically mentioned, which are necessary in order to provide HOT MIXED ASPHALTIC CONCRETE shall be included in the bid and shall conform in strength, quality of material and workmanship to what is usually provided the trade in general.

The City's intent is to obtain a reasonable bid from all interested bidders.

All bids must be accompanied by literature completely describing the HOT MIXED ASPHALTIC CONCRETE to be furnished. Each bidder must be a certified dealer authorized by the manufacturer he represents. Each bid shall contain a dealer and/or factory warranty as a guarantee of the product to be furnished. The guarantee shall be stated in the descriptive literature or by a letter.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1) Bidders Information

Each bid envelope shall contain ONLY ONE (1) Bid Proposal and shall be marked with the words "**Sealed Bid - Hot Mixed Asphaltic Concrete**".

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or a bank draft for One Hundred Dollars (\$100), such check to be certified or issued by either a State or National Bank and payable to the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, or in lieu thereof, a Two Hundred Dollar (\$200) bid bond, such bond to be issued by a surety authorized to do business in this State, payable to the City of Rapid City, Rapid City, South Dakota, as a guarantee of the bidder entering into a contract, for the supplying of HOT MIXED ASPHALTIC CONCRETE for the City of Rapid City. After this has been accomplished, the bidder's check or bid bond will be returned; the checks or bonds of all the unsuccessful bidders will be returned within thirty (30) days after the bids have been opened.

Bids submitted by mail, express courier, or common carrier cannot be accepted unless received in the City Finance Office prior to the time for the scheduled bid opening. Bids submitted by telefax cannot be accepted.

Each bid envelope shall contain the entire set of specifications. To save time for both the bidder and the City, the bidder shall fill out and complete "ARTICLE 5 CONTRACT DOCUMENT" upon submittal of the bid.

To the extent provided by statute, preference will be given to materials, products, and supplies found or produced within the State of South Dakota. (SDCL Chapter 5-19; Residential Preference Statute.)

The City reserves the right to reject all bids and unless all bids presented are rejected, the lowest responsible bid, in all cases, will be accepted. In case the low bid is not responsible or the bid is not made in accordance with the requirements of SDCL Chapter 5-19 or the low bid is withdrawn, the bid of the next lowest responsible bidder may be accepted; however, to the extent allowed by law the City reserves the right to accept the bid that is to the advantage of and is in the best interest of the City of Rapid City.

Payment for the HOT MIXED ASPHALTIC CONCRETE will be made BY CHECK, within a reasonable time after receipt and approval of the HOT MIXED ASPHALTIC CONCRETE, receipt of a City claim, and approval by the Common Council.

The unit price of the bid must be stated on the Bidder's Proposal form, along with the extended price bid. Unit price shall take precedence over extended price; written figures shall take precedence over numerical figures. Bid award will be based on the total extended price.

The HOT MIXED ASPHALTIC CONCRETE shall be F.O.B. Plant, Rapid City, South Dakota.

The quantities shown in the proposal are approximate for 2012. It shall be understood that the City of Rapid City reserves the right to purchase more or less than the specified amounts as it deems expedient.

Bids and quotations shall be for the period starting March 20, 2012, and ending approximately one (1) year later and shall show net delivered prices without State or Federal taxes. The City of Rapid City prefers to receive firm bids from all bidders. The City reserves the right to reject any bid not stating a firm price as not responsive.

2) Rejection

If the material does not meet the requirements of these specifications, notice shall be given to the vendor within TEN (10) days after the receipt of the HOT MIXED ASPHALTIC CONCRETE. In this event, payment shall be withheld, and the vendor shall remove the product from the City premises and shall replace it with a like amount of acceptable HOT MIXED ASPHALTIC CONCRETE.

3) Contract Extension

The City of Rapid City annually reserves the option of extending the 2012 contract through the calendar years of 2013, 2014 and 2015. The extension option may be exercised if agreed to by both parties.

DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS

HOT MIXED ASPHALTIC CONCRETE AND ASPHALT MAINTENANCE MIXTURES

CLASS G TYPE I AND CLASS G TYPE II

All Asphalt Cement content shall comply with each years approved mix design.

All Class G Asphaltic Concrete and Asphalt Maintenance Mixtures shall meet all specifications and requirements as outlined in the City of Rapid City Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction 2007 Edition.

No deviations will be allowed except with written permission from the City's Engineer.

All Asphalt, PG64-28, PG58-28 will be equal to or will exceed General Industry Standards. Certification can be obtained upon request, on all above materials.

MATERIAL LOADING

The bidder shall schedule load-up time in a manner that will incur the least amount of waiting period for the City trucks. The trucks shall line up in the order they arrive at the plant. Once in line, the trucks shall not be repositioned.

The City shall make an attempt to notify the supplier of any large usage dates (150 ton or more per day). This notification or the failure to notify the supplier shall not relieve the supplier of any obligation to load as stated above.

BASIS OF PAYMENT

Payment will be in full compensation for furnishing, mixing, loading and incidentals necessary to meet these specifications.

The price bid on G-I and G-II shall include the cost of Asphalt Cement. The price bid on Maintenance Mixture shall include the asphalt Cement.

Quantities listed in the Bidder's Proposal are estimates only, actual quantities will be regulated by the needs of the City of Rapid City during the contract term.

AVAILABILITY

Asphalt material outlined in this bid proposal shall be available each weather working day throughout the paving season. In case of a plant breakdown or other circumstance beyond hot plant control, notice will be given to the Rapid City Street Division as soon as possible. In the event that asphalt materials are not available from the specified facility and are purchased from an alternative facility, the successful bidder shall be responsible for paying the difference in the cost of said materials.
