

Hi Lindsey,

I have three Air Quality Board members whose terms are expiring 8/31/13 whose positions are appointed by the Mayor (one member at large whose term is expiring is appointed by the County Commission). The bylaws (attached) state that they can serve up to 2 three-year terms. Their term would begin 9/1/13 and end 8/31/16. Also attached is the current complete membership list for reference.

These are the expiring positions:

1. **Engineering Position** (RCMC 8.34.040 “member shall have graduated from an accredited college or university with an engineering degree”) – Currently held by Scott Landguth. This is his first full term (9/1/10 – 8/31/13), as he finished the unexpired term of Jason Love from 9/1/09-8/31/10. Out of sixteen possible board meetings where he was a voting member, he has attended four and missed twelve. He has expressed that he probably doesn’t have the time commitment for it due to work.
2. **Industry Position** (RCMC 8.34.040 doesn’t state any more criteria than “industry,” currently the two industry members work for Hills and Liens, typically these are industrial operations that have a Title V operating permit from the state DENR, meaning they are major sources of air pollution. Their knowledge of air permits, laws, and regulations are very helpful). One of the two industry positions is opening 8/31/13, currently held by Clint Allen from Hills Materials. This is his second of 2 three-year terms.
3. **Business Community** (RCMC 8.34.040 “member shall be associated with a business in the area regulated by this chapter or Pennington County Ordinance No. 12”) – This position is currently held by Dr. David C. Bartsch, MD. He will have completed his first term 8/31/13 so could possibly serve a second term.
