

City of Rapid City Vision Fund Parks & Recreation Projects Update

Vision Fund – Phase III Project – 2005

As of 2012, All Portions of the Parks & Recreation Vision Fund Projects from 2005 have been completed.

In 2012, Rapid City utilized the remaining balance of \$390,000 to match grant dollars from the South Dakota Department of Transportation Enhancement Program and Federal Highway Administration to complete the Greenway Trails and Pedestrian Facilities Project.

From 2006 through 2009, the following projects were completed with Vision Funding.

- Playground Equipment upgrades at Scott Mallow and College Park, and throughout the Park system.
- Park Entrance Signage was replaced and added throughout the entire Greenway and Park system
- A Tennis Court Complex and a restroom facility were built at Parkview Park
- The South Dakota School of Mines Football Field was converted to Artificial Turf
- Safety Issues were addressed at the ASA Softball Complex
- A portion of the Skyline Wilderness Area was purchased
- The Steven's High School Gym/Multipurpose Room was construction with intent for public use.
- Roosevelt Park received some outdoor amenities, including Gazebo, Fountains in the Pond, Pathway upgrades and drainage improvements.
- The Chuck Lien Family Park property was purchased with a portion of Vision Funds.
- Founders Park Improvements were completed during the Greenway Trails & Pedestrian Facilities project with help of grant match funds from Vision.
