- Basic Budget needed for Operations and Human Resources
- Wage increases reflect union contract changes
- Temp wages -> airport and limited part time help
- Worker comp increase from 77k in 2012 to estimated 208k in 2014 (up 168%)
- Increase in WAVI funding from 30k to 100k
- Total budget increase of 5.8% or \$684,512

2014 Capital Expenditures

- PSB remodel to start in late 2014
- 100k budgeted in CIP funds (matched by the County)

2014 Police Operating Budget

Wages and benefits: \$10,971,519

Other operating costs \$1,562,792

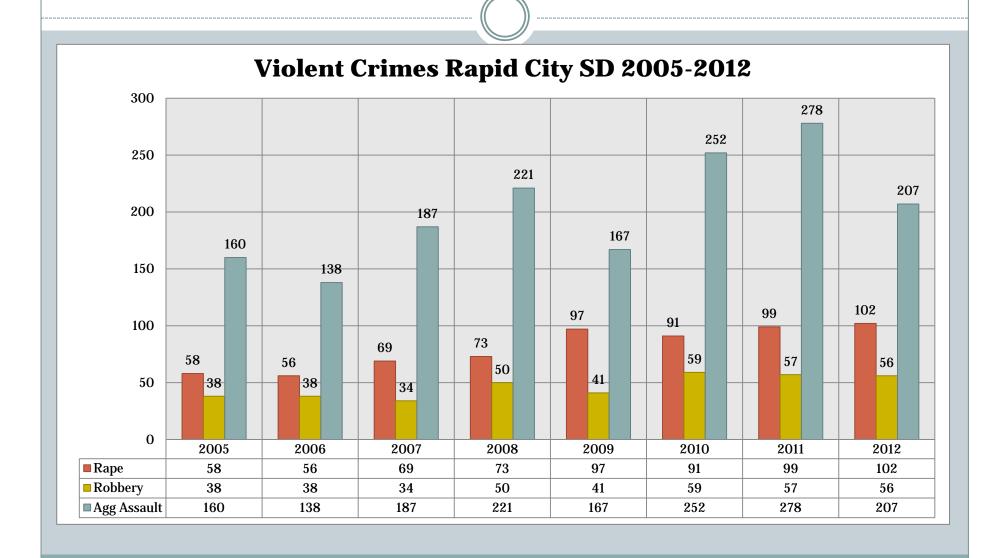

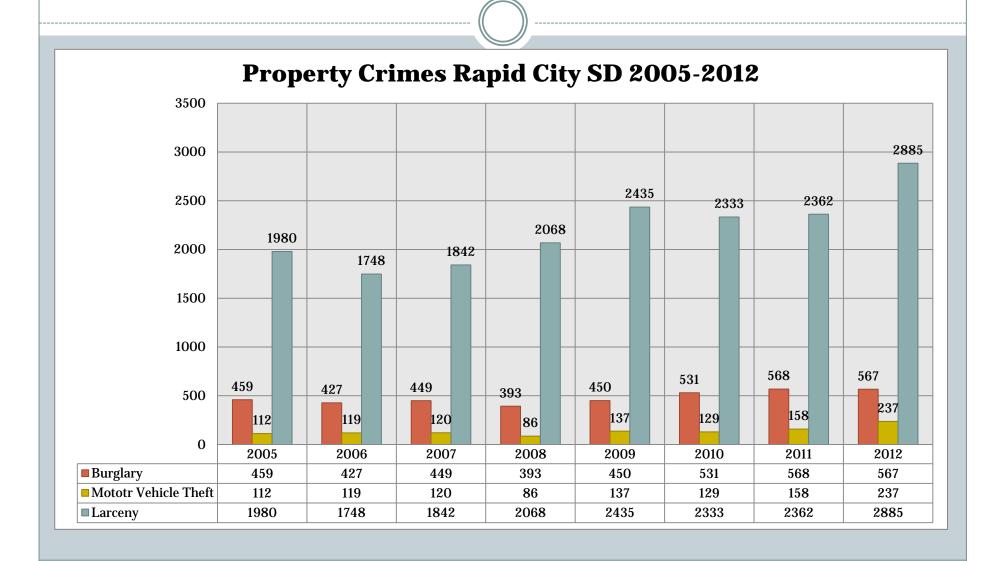

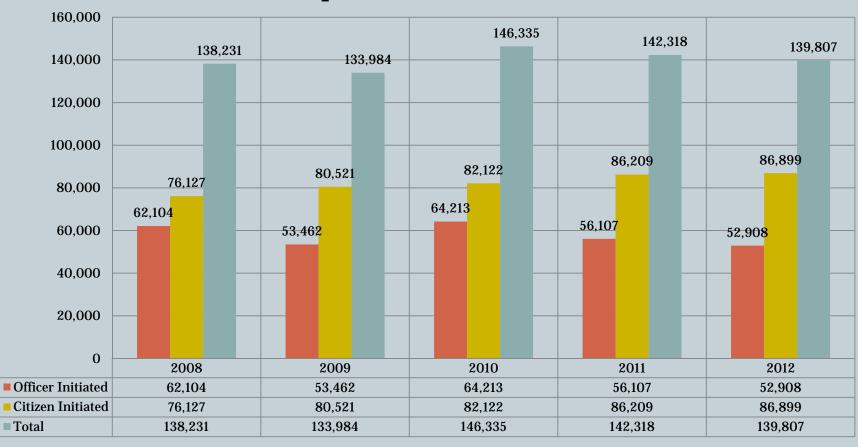
FTEs

Dispatch Budget

- Dispatch is a c0-funded operation City/County 66/33
- Three major funding sources: 911 surcharge fund, city and county. The revenue, including the 911 fund fluctuates slightly, then remaining expenses are paid by city and county.
- New County Admin Building
 - Dispatch will move
 - Simultaneous merge with State Radio
- Need to (1) expand and (2) update equipment

- Federal mandates have pushed technology changes
- Need for efficiency has pushed consolidation.
- Building costs once included furnishings, but late in process were removed.
 - Evidence Building
 - Dispatch
- This year, there are two parts to the budget:
 - General services
 - One-time expenses relating to the new county building

- General services : (annual) + radio debt repayment:
 - o Requested: \$1,244,746 (up \$194,746)
- Radio upgrade lease-purchase with Motorola
 - \$619,000 +interest over five years
 - Split between all funding sources, then City and County @ 66/33%
 - o City's share \$64,000 each year for five years
 - Separate from tower expansion project (CIP funds)
- One-time expenses
 - Furniture, radio consoles, software etc
 - o \$490,000
 - 300k paid out of dispatch reserves, then split between all funding sources
 - City's share in 2014 \$126,667
