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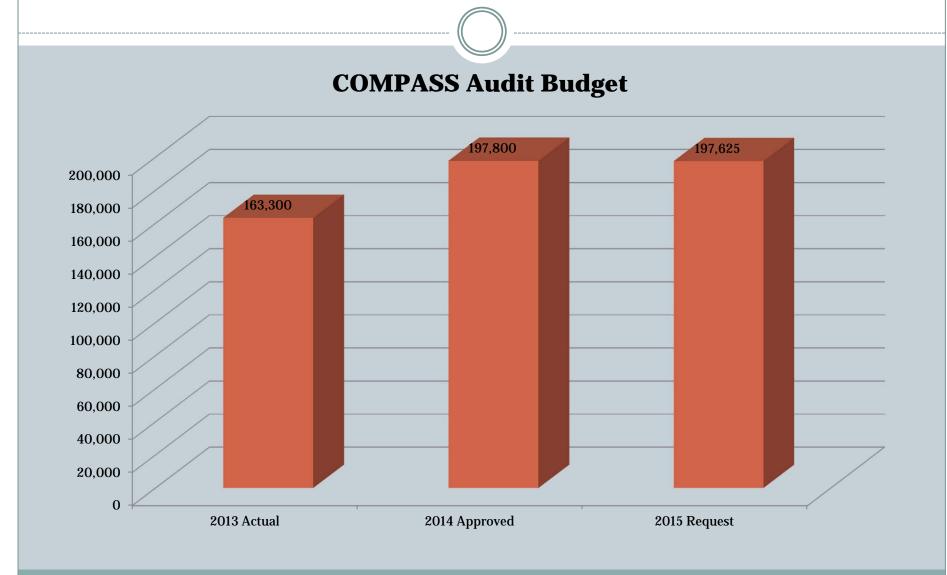
#### **OVERVIEW**

- The COMPASS Independent Audit Program was started in 2012. The program's first full year in operation was 2013.
- The COMPASS program is governed by a five member audit committee composed of three members of the public and two members of the City Council.
- The COMPASS Audit Committee oversees the work of two staff, the Chief Auditor and Staff Auditor.
- COMPASS Audit provides independent review and analysis of City operations and programs to provide the City Council with objective information on programs and services.
