
PETE GIRTZ INTERIM AIRPORT EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

- The Airport is governed by a five-member board appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council for three year terms.
- The Airport is a self-funded enterprise account receiving its operating revenue from rates and charges paid by Airport tenants.
- Capital improvements are funded through the Federal Airport Improvement Program (AIP):
 - 90% FAA / 5% SDDOT / 5% Airport
- The Airport employs 30 FTE including 7 full-time firefighters.
- The Airport pays the City \$105,185 in interdepartmental charges.

- The Airport uses the latest millimeter wave Advanced Imaging Technology (AIT) units for passenger screening.

- The Airport offers mobile boarding pass technology.
- The Airport is one of the first in the area to receive an ADS-B antenna from the FAA as part of the Next Generation of air traffic. It provides improved navigation and communications.


