### Public Safety Building Renovation Project – 2014/2015 Preliminary Planning Timeline

- **Phase 1**
  - Fall 2014
    - Renovate 4<sup>th</sup> floor to prepare for SO and PD Administration Floor.
      - Approximately 50/50 space split.
      - Expanded lobby area
      - Conference Room Construction – likely on west end
      - New carpet/paint
    - Renovate 2<sup>nd</sup> floor dispatch area into a large training room.
- **Phase 2**
  - Winter 2014
    - Move SO and PD admin to 4<sup>th</sup> floor.
    - Move SO and PD training functions to 2<sup>nd</sup> floor office space.
    - Move PD Records to 2<sup>nd</sup> floor office space.
    - Move PD Special Ops to 2<sup>nd</sup> floor office space.
    - Move PD Compliance to 2<sup>nd</sup> floor office space.
    - Move PD Community Relations to 4<sup>th</sup> floor
    - Move ICAC to West Wing.
- **Phase 3**
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2015
  - Renovate 1<sup>st</sup> floor of PSB.
    - Prepare for SO Patrol move to 1<sup>st</sup> floor.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2015
    - Move SO Patrol to 1<sup>st</sup> floor (Transport?)
- **Phase 5**
  - Summer/Fall 2015
    - Renovate basement space for RCPD Expansion
      - Locker Room Move/Expansion
- **Parking**
  - Secure parking area – top floor of ramp

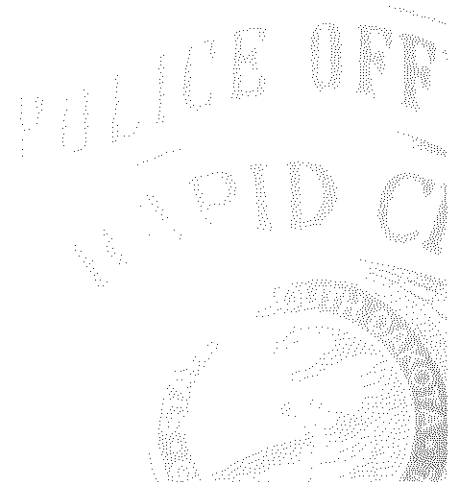

On behalf of the Pennington County JDAI Steering Committee which is made up of key players from multiple governmental and community based entities, it is our pleasure to write a letter in support of the implementation of an Evening Reporting Center (ERC) managed by Lutheran Social Services. We agree that there is a significant need for this type of program and are in full support of the implementation of an ERC program in Pennington County.

One of the goals of the JDAI is to identify community-based organizations that are willing and able to implement programming to provide alternatives to a referral to Secure Detention. These alternatives are geared towards ensuring court appearances and reducing the likelihood of re-arrest while allowing youth to continue attending school and remain at home.

The ERC is for youth age 10 to 17 that have a pending court appearance and are at risk of being placed in Secure Detention. The primary emphasis of the ERC program is to keep youth involved in positive experiences during the time periods when they are most likely to recidivate, generally during the after school and early evening hours when there may not be adult supervision at their home.

The Pennington County JDAI Steering Committee has had multiple discussions regarding the need of an ERC as this program will have a positive impact on not only decreasing the detention center population, but will help the schools and the community as a whole by providing a program to keep the youth engaged in a positive environment. The JDAI Steering Committee has agreed that Lutheran Social Services has proven their willingness and ability to implement JDAI related programming and they have exceeded the expectations of not only us as JDAI Co-Chairs, but all agencies involved in the JDAI work.
