SUBJECT: Idle Time Compliance/ Motel Room Compensation

Hello Wal-Mart Drivers!

Effective March 1st 2006, we will no longer idle anywhere for more than 3 minutes. We are taking this stance because of our commitment to Environmental Sustainability and our efforts to meet all Local, State and Federal laws.

Unfortunately not all of our tractors are equipped with auxiliary power units (APUs). The process of installing APU's is on-going and will be completed by May 1st 2006.

If your truck does not have an APU or an Espar heater you will be authorized to secure a hotel room for your break if you deem conditions are necessary.

Compensation for this action will be paid as follows: (Effective March 1, 2006 through May 1, 2006)

- Mileage for the miles driven to the hotel and back to secure your trailer
- Lay-over pay for 10 hour lay over in the hotel room
- Pig pay to re-hook to the trailer, (FDP will pay UT for the time spent hooking to your trailer)
- GTM's if drivers have to burn hours to ensure they are in position to break at a hotel we will
 pay them wait time (unscheduled time under FDP) for hours burned.

Please note that some of you may be able to take your trailer with you to the hotel. Also please visit with your local management team and safety manger to ensure you understand the DOT personal conveyance logging criteria. When selecting a hotel please keep expense control in mind.

You may request an additional \$150 expense money from your local transportation office. Please complete the attached request if you would like to receive it.
