

Revised Proposal

Dear Mr. Titus:

Based on our discussion today we are submitting this revised proposal and Services Agreement for the referenced project. The original proposal was dated December 21, 2000. We had previously understood that this project will be completed as part of our existing geotechnical services contract for the year 2000, but as requested we have prepared a separate agreement form specific for this project. The project consists of a sanitary sewer trunk line extension on Sheridan Lake Road from approximately South Wildwood Drive to Croyle Avenue. CETEC Engineering has provided an alignment map with proposed boring locations. We understand that CETEC will stake the borings by January 3, 2001 and advise us such that we can call utility locates and finalize bore locations. A total of 15 borings are currently planned.

To evaluate the existing soil conditions, a total of 9 borings are requested to a depth of approximately 15 feet, and 6 borings to a depth of approximately 25 feet. Field testing will be performed, and samples will be extracted for further laboratory analysis. Select soil samples will be tested in our laboratory to determine their general classification, and physical properties. At two locations (near Sta 34+35 and Sta 50+04) soil samples will be collected for laboratory determination of resistivity. The scope of work may be expanded to include additional borings for rock areas, or other areas of concern. The cost for the additional borings is not currently included in the total cost estimate, but will be completed if necessary at the standard unit rates shown. Borings into bedrock via coring or other techniques is not anticipated or requested for this project. At Sta 48+00 there is current consideration for placement of a gabion type wall structure. Additional services for this structure may be required depending upon general soil conditions encountered and final design alignment. The scope of services for any additional drilling or geotechnical design parameters will be determined at a later date.

It is currently anticipated that the field work for this project will be completed during the week of January 8th, 2001. We anticipate coordinating with Pennington County to obtain any necessary right-of-way work permits. Upon completion of the field and laboratory testing, and our analysis, a report will be prepared that transmits the testing results. In

general our report will provide the boring logs and a brief general discussion of conditions encountered. Specific design recommendations, or design of any shoring structures necessary for construction is also beyond the scope of this report.

The estimated costs for the services described are outlined on the following page. We will not exceed the cost estimate without justification, and prior approval.
