Following direction from the City Council the Public Works Department contacted five consulting firms in an effort to obtain quotes for providing observation services for water and sewer lines being installed by Rapid Construction. Of the five firms contacted two quotes were submitted with the remaining three abstaining for various reasons.

The lowest quote was submitted by Project Solutions and their rate was \$75 per hour. The second quote was from FourFront Design and was for \$85 per hour. Public Works recommends contracting with Project Solution for these services.

Thank you for the opportunity to submit our hourly rate for a construction observer to perform observation of Rapid Construction during their laying water or sewer pipes. I was out sick yesterday and was unable to submit a quote. In consideration of the unknowns related to this work i.e. amount of work, required time for administration of the work, number of construction sites and concurrent construction, our quoted hourly rate includes an increased multiplier to cover this uncertainty. Therefore the rate for an observer will be \$85 per hour.

Subject: Rapid Construction Inspection

Gentleman,

Following up on our phone conversations, the City is wanting to enter into an agreement with a firm to provide observation services for the installation of water and sewer lines. In particular, the observation of Rapid Construction as they install these utilities. This would include, "The observation of Rapid Construction's work pertaining to the laying of water and sewer lines, the bedding thereof and the backfill of trenches excavated for the purpose of laying said lines".

Terms of the agreement between the City and Rapid Construction explicitly state they shall not perform any work laying water or sewer pipes or connecting water or sewer pipes to the City's infrastructure unless an observer is present. Rapid Construction shall notify the observer not less than two business days prior to doing work that requires an inspection.

The City will directly pay the firm doing the observation. The City is requesting a quote for providing this service. Observation shall be done only by qualified construction observers (not engineers). Observation services shall be defined as providing a daily written/photo log of construction activities and being onsite to visualize the materials and construction methods employed. Should any materials testing be required the observer shall notify the City Engineer and the City will make arrangements to perform those tasks.

Services shall be need for a period of 12 months starting on December 4, 2007 and terminating on December 3, 2008. Rapid Construction will retrain full responsibility for their work and the City/observer is in no way guaranteeing or insuring this work. If you are interested in providing this service please send me a quote listing

your observation hourly fee by Tuesday, November 27th at 3:00 pm. The lowest quote will be selected. Also, should your firm currently be under contract in anyway with Midland Atlantic (Rushmore Crossing Project) we ask that you do not provide a quote due to a possible conflict of interest.
