The Operational Plan for the Master's Challenge Bull Riding event is as follows:

Saturday, Aug 31, 2013 - Set up begins: Chutes, Arena & Back Pens, (Provided by Buffington Rodeo Company.) Arena grounds will not be tilled until the day of the event due to Rain Disturbance and Dust Control.

Wed-Friday, Sep 3-6, 2013 - Portable restroom set up, concession stands, and bleachers set.

Saturday, Sept 07, 2013 - all preliminaries are finished. Bulls will arrive late morning / early afternoon and will be facilitated in specialized back pens from the time they arrive through the duration of the event. All trucks and trailers will be transported to authorized areas off site until the event is over. Ground prep will begin at 10am (Arena Maintenance, Dust Control, Trash Cans, Etc.) Security, Traffic Personnel, Medics and all Event Personnel will be on site by 2pm. Bull Riders arrive and Registrations scheduled to be open from 2pm-4pm. Spectators anticipated to begin arriving around 3:30pm. Additional Overflow Parking will be available with shuttle if needed. Event Kickoff - 4pm / Event Concludes - Est. 7pm. Immediately following event bulls will be picked up and transported to their destination for the evening. All land will be reclaimed with 14 days of the event.

- 1. 30 Professional Bull Riders & 40 Professional Bulls All livestock will be held in authorized back pens for the duration of the event. No animal will be free to roam, wander or eat outside of its restricted area. Fans will not be in contact with livestock at anytime.
- 2. Arena: Chutes, Panels and Back Pens (provided by Buffington Rodeo Company)
- 3. <u>Insurance</u>: See attached copy
- 4. Gate Fee: \$5.00per person / Kids free
- 5. <u>Parking</u>: 117 Spaces (468 People) on site. Additional parking will be requested of the city counsel for use of either Rapid City Horace Mann Swimming Pool or the Rapid City Civic Center.
- **6. Bleachers:** Adequate seating will be available up to 500 people, Additional scating areas will be open for lawn chairs, etc.
- 7. Security & Traffic Directors: Appointed by the Dove Christian Center
- 8. Emergency Personnel: Paramedics & Designated Area on site.
- 9. Concessions: A trailer with limited concessions: water, soda, candy, etc.
- 10. Restrooms: Portable restrooms will be on site (Approx. 4Men, 12Wmen, 4HC)
