Blada called the meeting to order at 8:43 am.

1123 Kansas City Street – Early Foundations Child Care – Ground Sign

Jackson moved and Kingsbury seconded to approve the ground sign for Early Foundations Child Care at 1123 Kansas City Street. Day described the current signs indicating that the parking lot sign and awning sign will be removed, and the marble wall sign within the brick structure will be covered. Day further described the proposed sign and indicated that the lettering will be black. Bulman explained that the sign application is scheduled to be heard at the Sign Board of Appeals to allow a sign larger than one square foot, as the property is located within a residential zoning district. **The motion to approve the ground sign for Early Foundations Child Care at 1123 Kansas City Street passed unanimously.**

932 St. Joseph Street – Don Hermann Agency – Wall Sign

Jackson moved and Kingsbury seconded to approve the wall sign for Don Hermann Agency at 932 St. Joseph Street. Rutter described the sign and indicated that this will be the last sign allowed on the wall as they have reached the maximum square footage for signs on the property. **The motion to approve the wall sign for Don Hermann Agency at 932 St. Joseph Street passed unanimously.**
