Course Content:

- Intermodal tank container design and construction
- Cargo tank design and construction
- Procedures for drilling cargo tank with exercise
- Drum to drum transfer exercise
- Cargo tank emergency product removal methods with exercise
- Overpacking drums and small containers with exercise
- Grounding and bonding with exercise
- Damage assessment of cargo tanks
- Flaring of MC 330/331

Prerequisites:

We recommend that applicant have had prior hazmat training or experience in the incident command system, decontamination procedures, personal protective equipment, and standard safe operating procedures. Attendance at either an operations level or technician level course satisfies these requirements.

Course Duration:

5 days, 40 hours, including 20 hours of field exercises. The bus leaves the Holiday inn at 6:45 a.m. SHARP. The course concludes on Friday at 4:00 p.m.
