Fence Height Exception - Dino Hill radio tower site improvement project

We are requesting a fence height exception to allow a six foot chain link security fence toped with one foot of barbed wire at the Dino Hill radio tower site in Dinosaur Park.

The fence portion of this project entails the installation of approximately 55' of six foot heavy duty chain link fence topped with one foot of three-strand barbed wire and a four foot wide gate. The total height of the fence will be seven feet, thus the request for this fence height exception.

The fence is intended to prevent public access to the base of the radio tower (a climbing/falling hazard) as well as provide security for a new backup power generator and related propane tank.

On November 8th, 2007, the Planning Commission approved the 11-6-19 review for this project with the fence height exception stipulation.

The total cost of this project is \$2,500.00 and is being funded by Homeland Security grant funds.
