**ORDINANCE NO.**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6.12.035 OF CHAPTER 6.12 OF THE RAPID CITY MUNICIPAL CODE EXEMPTING CERTAIN AREAS FROM THE LEASH LAW REQUIREMENT.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Rapid City that Section 6.12.035 of Chapter 6.12 of the Rapid City Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

**6.12.035 Exceptions.**

Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 6.12.030 of this chapter, the following areas are exempt from the requirements of that section:

- A. Braeburn Addition-West of Cleghorn Springs Fish Hatchery at the hockey rink;
- B. Wilderness Park-East of City Springs Road and north of the picnic area;
- ~~C. Mary Hall Park North of Canyon Lake Senior Citizens Center along Lime Creek;~~
- ~~C.D. Knollwood Metering Dam-North of Racine Street and west of LaCrosse Street;~~
- D.E. Robbinsdale Park-South of the picnic area, east of Harney Little League complex and north of Fairmont Boulevard.

The requirements of Section 6.08.270 of this title shall apply to these designated areas.
